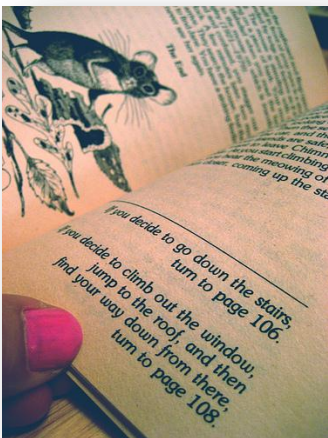
Choose Your Own Adventure!
